

As readers we will:

- Develop confidence in reading aloud
- Consolidate key reading skills including inference, retrieval, prediction, summarising, vocabulary and explanation.
- Draw inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives

As mathematicians we will focus on:

- Recapping and consolidating key knowledge and maths skills through themed projects and topics – such as setting up our own restaurant and travelling.

As scientists we will:

- Describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals
- Give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics.

As historians will:

- compare life in Baghdad and London (AD 900).
- understand the importance of The House of Wisdom
- know the impact of discoveries during the 'Golden Age of Islam'
- Understand why the Early Islamic Civilisation became a major power



In computing we will:

- Apply our knowledge of coding to a microbit programme.
- Apply word processing skills in real life context.

As athletes we will:

- how to improve technique to jump and throw
- further the importance of larger muscle groups in your body to produce power
- use tactics which involve bowlers and fielders working together
- know the importance of types of fitness to a game.
- plan to outwit the opposition individually as a pair or as a team when they are batting bowling and fielding

In R.E we will:

- Explore religion through art – including the Islamic forms of art.
- Compare art throughout religions.

As foreign language speakers we will:

- Understand how to communicate regarding animals, specifically pets.
- We will learn the correct punctuation and vocabulary when asking questions in french

As writers we will:

- Correctly punctuate speech and use dialogue which advances a narrative.
- Explore non-fiction
- Understand poetry devices and language.
- Develop success criteria for a story retell
- Draft, edit and self-correct my own published piece of work.
- Read my work aloud.
