



Key Vocabulary


source	a spring or fountain head from which a river or stream issues.
floodplain	an area of low-lying ground next to a river, and subject to flooding.
mouth	The place where a river enters the sea.
precipitation	rain, snow, sleet or hail that falls to or condenses on the ground.
meander	To follow a winding course.
evaporation	The process of turning from liquid into vapour.
stream	A small, narrow river.
bank	The land alongside or sloping down to a river or lake

River Facts




The Water Cycle
