Red list travel ban countries – please read the link

If you have been in or through any of the countries listed in the link below in the previous 10 days, you will be refused entry to the UK.

If you are a British or Irish National, or you have residence rights in the UK, you will be able to enter. You must <u>quarantine in a government approved hotel</u> for 10 days. You cannot use the <u>Test to Release scheme</u>

<u>People Arriving in England who have visited or passed through a Red List Country – please read the link</u>

The guidance below is for people arriving in England who have visited or passed through a country where travel to the UK is banned (sometimes called <u>'red list' countries</u> in the 10 days before their arrival.

Providing false or deliberately misleading information when filling out your passenger locator form is an offence punishable by imprisonment.

You could be fined up to £10,000, imprisoned for up to 10 years, or both, if you do not provide accurate details about the countries you have visited in the 10 days before you arrived in the UK. If you break the quarantine rules you may face a penalty of up to £10,000
