As readers we will be:

- Exploring books about different types of plants and gardening.
- Reading our reading book 3 times a week to help practice our phonics.
- Reading at home 4 times a week to help improve our reading.
- Asking relevant questions to extend our understanding and knowledge.
- Using our phonics to sound out words.
- Reading with expression.

As sportspeople we will be:

- Focusing on our fundamental movement skills, developing our jumping, dodging, balance and coordination and target throwing skills.
- Using bench ball to help us continue developing our rolling, striking, and throwing in more complex environments.

As researchers we will be able to:

- Find out how Jews celebrate Purim.
- Discover the Story of Ester and its significance for this festival.

As musicians, we will be:

- Composing music that represents weather sounds. Choose sounds to create a desired impact and vary the beat.
- Use pictures and symbols to represent sounds and order for compositions.

As mathematicians we will focus on:

- Place value to 50.
- Partitioning into tens and ones.
- Measuring lengths using cm.
- Measuring and comparing mass.
- Measuring and comparing capacity.

Our topic this term is How does your garden grow?

As Scientists we will:

- Learn about the role of worms in the garden.
- Discover how important bees are in helping our garden to grow.
- Help to look after the birds and learn their role in the garden.
- Identify the different types of mini beasts you can find in the school garden.

In computing we will be:

- Creating simple spreadsheets using calculation functions.
- Collecting data to create pictograms.

In our topic we will be:

- Identifying plants in our local area.
- Naming and comparing parts of plants.
- Learning what plants need to grow.
- Looking at different fruit and vegetable plants in our school gardens.

As writers we will:

- Practise sounding out words using our phonics.
- Put finger spaces in between our words.
- Use capital letters and full stops in our sentences.
- Practise forming all our letters correctly.
- Add 'and' to join two short sentences together.
- Use noun phrases to add description.
- Begin to use bossy verbs to create instructions.

As artists we will be:

- Looking at Andy Goldsworthy who is famous for making natural sculptures.
- Examining pattern, texture, line and shape to make our own natural sculptures in 3D form.
